□May encompass multiple identical analyzers or devices. Different test systems may be used for the same analyte. □In many situations, tests performed on the same analyzer may be considered one test system; however, if there are any tests with unique aspects, competency must be assessed as a separate test system.

Test methods and competency assessments. The six methods of competency assessment listed in Table 1 are required for laboratory testing, but not all tasks in the Transfusion Service are laboratory tests. Thawing plasma, dispensing a blood component, or ordering blood from the blood supplier, for example, are not test-related activities.

Returning unused blood: If blood is not transfused, it must be returned to the Blood Bank within 30 minutes of the time that it was issued. NOTE: Blood must be stored in a Blood Bank monitored refrigerator with an alarm. The only refrigerator outside the Blood Bank that is suitable for blood storage is located in the Operating Room area.
